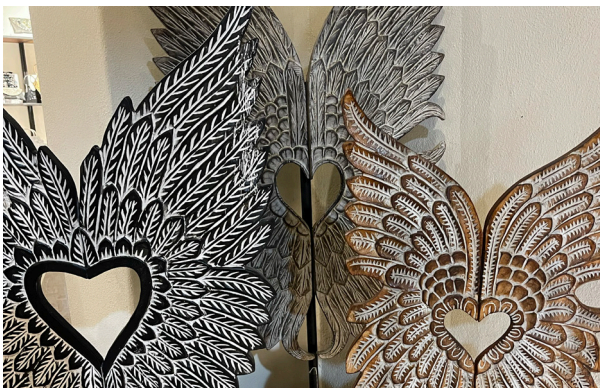




SAN JOSE DEL CABO.

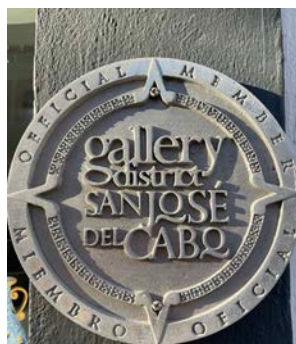
This Mission city founded in 1730, exudes the vision of a traditional Mexican downtown, still displaying pure colonial history through its colorful buildings and cobblestone streets.

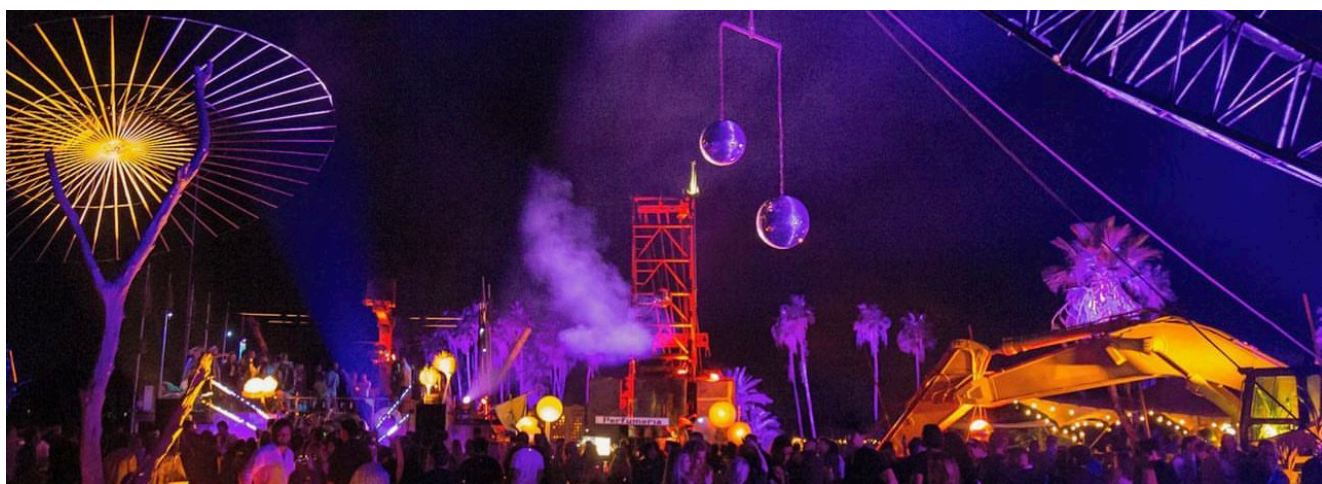
ARTISTIC SCENE
